

WORM ALERT

Dear Parent,

There have been cases of threadworms at this school/centre. This is not a cause for concern, as your child may not be affected. However, threadworms are contagious.

In order to determine if your child has been infected with threadworms, we are asking all parents to look out for the tell-tale signs. Often there are no symptoms, but the most common signs of threadworm infestation include:

- Persistent scratching of the bottom and/or itchy bottom.
- Restless sleep.
- Loss of appetite and irritability.

To confirm any suspicions of worms:

- Look for moving worms around the anus about an hour after the child has gone to bed.
- See if there are worms on the outside surface of bowel motions.

If you notice any of the above signs, or if you require further information, please contact your local pharmacy, as treatment is readily available and easy to take.

We encourage you to ensure that this problem is solved quickly by determining if your child is affected and seeking recognised threadworm treatment if necessary.
